

Medicare Open Enrollment

Every year October 15 through December 7 is shopping season (Open Enrollment) for Medicare prescription drug and Medicare Advantage plans.

If you're already enrolled in a Medicare Part D prescription plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan and you don't want to make changes to your coverage for the coming year, you don't need to do anything during the shopping season, assuming your current plan will continue to be available. (If your plan is being discontinued and isn't eligible for renewal, you will receive a non-renewal notice from your carrier prior to October 15)

Even if you're confident that you want to keep your current coverage for next year, it's important to make sure you understand any changes that may apply, and that you've double checked to make sure that your current plan is still the best available option. The available plans and what they cover changes from one year to the next, so even if the plan you have now was the best option when you shopped last year, it's important to verify that again before you lock yourself in for another year.
